Sealed tenders in plain papers are invited from the intending participants having license under Orissa Minerals (Prevention of Theft, Smuggling & Illegal Mining and Regulation of Possession, Storage Trading and Transportation) Rules – 2007 dealing with coal for dispose the seized and confiscated coal as mentioned below lying in the plant premises of OMFED Diary, Salapada will be put into public auction on “As is where is basis”. Sealed tenders quoted with offer price will be received in the office of undersigned by 3.00 PM on 04.12.2019 and will be opened on the same day at 4.00 PM in presence of all the bidders or their authorized persons. The tender paper should accompany with EMD of Rs. 1200.00 only in shape of Demand Draft payable at any nationalized bank in favour of the Mining Officer, Keonjhar Circle, Keonjhar failing which the tender application shall not be considered. The EMD of successful bidders shall be adjusted against the bid value and the others will be refunded. The highest bidders whose tender is accepted shall have to deposit at least 25% of the offered amount immediately after the sale is confirmed or else the tender shall be treated as null and void and and the EMD shall be forfeited to Govt. The balance amount should be deposited within seven days from the date of acceptance of tender failing which 25% of the offered amount deposited earlier shall be forfeited to Govt. The Stock of coal under auction may be inspected by any prospective participant during working hours of any working day in the OMFED Diary Plant, Salapada with prior permission of the undersigned. The successful bidder should remove the coal from site within 30 days from the date of issue of lifting order under the provision of OM(PTS IMRPSTT) Rules, 2007. Since the disposal of coal is being held “as is where is”basis, the auctioning authority shall not have any responsibility towards quality and quantity. In case any quantity found in excess of the auctioned quantity, the differential value has to be deposited by the auction holder for that quantity. 
