No. 271244/2021 dated 18.3.2021 of the Chief Executive Officer, NITI Aayog, New Delhi and say that it has been decided by NITI Aayog that no financial grant from Central Government will be disbursed to any NGO/VO without obtaining the Unique ID generated from NGO DARPAN portal in order to monitor & track fund flow to the same.

Further, NGO must be registered in PFMS as NGO type agency, While releasing funds to NGOs implementing the schemes, State treasuries need to ensure that funds are released to NGOs in the same bank account which is registered in PFMS for that particular agency.

You are, therefore, requested to please instruct the concerned NGOs under your control to register on the NGO DARPAN portal of NITI Aayog and obtain the Unique ID positively in order to monitor & track fund flow to the same.



Reference is invited to NITI Aayog's D.O No. 27/1244/2021/OroCEO dated 18.03.2021 on the above mentioned subject (copy enclosed)

2 This is with regard to NGOs/VOs implementing the schemes /programmes of Government of India. It has been decided that no financial grant from Central Government will be disbursed to any NGO/VO without obtaining the Unique ID generated from NGO DARPAN portal of NITI Aayog in order to monitor & track fund flow to the same. Accordingly the UT/State Government are advised to ensure strict compliance to the following

- i. State Governments/Govt. of UTs receiving grants from Central Ministries / Departments and in turn implementing the schemes / programmes through NGOs should ensure that the respective NGOs/VOs are registered on the NGO-DARPAN portal of NITI Aayog. NGOs /VOs should also obtain the Unique ID after furnishing the requisite PAN and Aadhaar details.
- ii. NGO / VO must be registered in PFMS as NGO type agency. While releasing funds to NGOs /VOs implementing the schemes/ programmes, State Treasuries needs to ensure that they have already received Agency details along with NGO Darpan ID from PFMS.
- iii. It may be ensured that State Treasuries release funds to NGO / VO in the same bank account which is registered in PFMS for that particular agency.

Kind reference is invited to various instructions issued earlier and decisions in the meeting on 26.2.2021 to discuss the progress of integration of the online portals of Central Ministries/Departments with NCO Darpan Portal and related actions. (Annexure-I). It is reiterated that no financial grant should be disbursed to any NGO without obtaining Unique ID of NII Darpan Portal. It was also stressed that Ministries, which have not developed their online portal so far, in consultation with NIC teams of their respective Ministries, develop this facility within 15 days on top most priority and integrate it with the Darpan Portal.

2. Ministries/Departments need to follow the system both for Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes. For Centrally Sponsored Schemes, a proposed protocol developed by Controller General of Accounts to capture payments to NGO is enclosed at Annexure-II. Broad Actions to be initiated by all concerned for implementation is enclosed at Annexure-III.

3. The matter should be given top most priority and action taken in this regard, should be intimated to NII Aayog by 31.3.2021. **Subject: Record of discussion of the meeting held on 26th February 2021,
under the Chairmanship of CEO, NITI Aayog. Reg.**

A meeting was held on 26th February 2021 under the Chairmanship of CEO, NITI Aayog to discuss the progress of integration of the Grants in Aid portals of Central Ministries / Departments with NGO Darpan portal.

2. After detail deliberations the following decisions were reiterated by the CEO, NITI Aayog.

3. Action points:

- i. As suggested earlier no financial grants under any circumstances shall be disbursed to any NGO without obtaining a Unique ID number generated from the NGO-Darpan portal of NITI Aayog.

Action by all Ministries / Departments

- ii. Ministries which have not developed online portal so far should, in consultation with NIC teams of their respective Ministries should develop this facility within 10 days and integrate on Darpan portal

Action by all Ministries / Departments

- iii. Ministries should make Darpan ID mandatory for all their schemes having NGO Components (both Central Sector Schemes & Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS)).

Action by all Ministries / Departments

- iv. Ministries which have already put in place their computerized system or separate portal for receiving and processing applications for grants should make transition into the integrated portal as soon as possible.

Action by all Ministries / Departments

- vi. Central Ministries / Departments to develop a system in every scheme to verify and ensure whether the NGO has NGO Darpan Unique ID, spent money for the purpose for which the grant was given.

Action by all Ministries / Departments

- vii. All Departments/ Ministries which release grants to the state Governments (rather than directly to the NGOs/ VOs), and the State Governments in turn implement the schemes/ programmes through the NGOs at their end make sure the respective States/ UTs to require such NGOs/ VOs also to sign-up on the NGO-DARPAN portal of NITI Aayog and obtain the Unique ID after furnishing the requisite PAN and Aadhaar details.

Action by all Ministries / Departments

viii. PFMS will share SOPs for fund release to the NGOs for both Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes.

Action by: PFMS

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Proposed Protocol for CSS to capture payments to NGOs:

NITI Aayog/ Dept of Expenditure needs to issue clear instructions to ensure that if NGO is going to get funds from Center Govt/State Govt, that NGO must be registered in NGO DARPAN Portal and obtain DARPAN ID.

NITI Aayog/ Dept of Expenditure needs to issue clear instructions to ensure that if NGO is going to get funds from Center Govt/State Govt, that NGO must be registered in PFMS as NGO type agency

PFMS will make capturing of NGO Darpan ID mandatory in agency registration process for CSS type schemes.

PFMS will share the details of NGO type agencies with State Treasuries through API providing critical attributes like Bank Account Details , Agency Name, NGO Darpan ID etc.

While doing fund release to NGO's, State treasuries needs to ensure that they have already received Agency Details along with NGO Darpan ID from PFMS.

It needs to be ensured that State Treasuries release funds to NGO type agencies in the same bank account which is registered in PFMS for that particular agency.

While sharing data of releases to PFMS through integration, State Treasuries need to share the PFMS agency code of NGO also.

Releases made to NGO Type agencies through EAT module will automatically get captured if the agency is registered in PFMS with NGO Darpan ID.

Above process will enable capturing of releases to NGO's by State Treasuries as well as through PFMS EAT module.

PFMS will share the release details captured as above with NGO Darpan Portal through the existing API integration.

Broad Actions to be initiated by all concerned for implementation

- (1) While registration system may cover all the NGOs irrespective of the system followed by them for incorporation/registration, the financial management system may cover only those grants that are released to them by various Ministries/Departments.
- (2) SOPs for registration of NGOs may be suitably incorporated in the procedures of FCRA, 80G and CSR systems in consultation with their respective Ministries/Departments.
- (3) Requisite decision support systems covering aspects like performance parameters, preventing duplication and misuse, overall consistency in penal processes, genuineness of NGOs etc. may be developed and integrated within the overall work flow of the Ministries/Departments concerned.
- (4) Grant management system may be suitably integrated with PFMS rather than becoming a stand-alone system. It may cover the entire life cycle of projects. Both Central and Centrally Sponsored Schemes may be covered. Since PFMS is currently not mandatory for CSS up to the last point of expenditure, therefore appropriate reporting system may be evolved for this purpose.
- (5) Both (3) and (4) above may take into account specific procedural requirements of different Ministries/Departments and such other nuances.
- (6) The mechanism to monitor effective and efficient use of funds may use suitable technology tools like GIS, data analytics, AI etc. and may be able to generate all the required MIS for multi-level reviews.
