

KEONJHARGARH BLOCK.

The name of the Block is Keonjhargarh *Block*. It started functioning in the year 1955. The geographical area of this Block is 297 Sqr. Miles. The population as per 2011 census of this Block is 162148 out of which Male Population is 81305, Female Population is 80843, ST Population is 81567 SC Population is 16082 and Others are 64499 no. The literate population of this Block is 94723. Category wise the population percentage of this Block is as follows, Male:- 50.14, Female :- 49.86, ST :- 50.3, SC : 09.9, Oth :- 39.8 and literate population percentage is 58.4. The total Households of this Block is 35963 no. This Block consists of 24 no. of GPs in which there are 231 Revenue villages and 09 hamlets. The Block has 01 no. of CHC , 05 no. of New PHC, 02 no. of Govt. Homeopathy Dispensary, 30 no. of ANM centers, 190 Asha centers, 261 no. of AW centers, 198 no. of GKS for facilitation of better health care of the villagers. For education regards the Block has 141 no. of PS, 25 no. of PUPS, 11 no. of NUPS, 21 no. of UPS, 17 no. of UGMES, 38 no. of High Schools, 03 no. of Degree Colleges and 02 no. of Degree Engineering Colleges. The Block provides drinking water to the inhabitants through 1584 no. of Tube Wells, 47 Wells and 25 no. of Piped Water System. To irrigate its agricultural fields the Block has 03 MIPs. 36 no. of Financial Institutions and 02 no. of LAMPS are functioning in the Block and they are financing the villagers in respect of ISB, Agriculture, Pisciculture and all sort of segments including credit linkage to SHG groups. 902 no. of Women Self Help Groups are functioning under the guidance of this Block. To provide better treatment to the Live Stocks the Block has 02 no. of VAS centre and 18 no. of LI centers. The Block has 29 no. of Weekly Hats, 403 no. of Tank/Bandha, 14 no. Bagayat and 47no. of Kaina houses which are functioning by different GPs of the Block. Alphabetically the name of the GPs are Baradapal, Bauripada, Bodapalasa, Dimbo, Gobardhan, Handibhanga, Janardanpur, Kandraposi, Kathabari, Kaunrikala, Mahadeijoda, Maidankle, Mandua, Naranpur, Nelung, Nuagaon, Padampur, Palasponga, Parjanpur, Raghunathpur, Raikala, Raisuan, Sankiri And Sirispal.

GP PROFILE

01. BARADAPAL G.P :- Baradapal GP hqr. is nearly 17 Kms away from Block hqr. This GP consists of 04 villages and 11 Wards. The GP has its own Office Building, 07 nos. of GP Tanks. The population of the GP is 3959 out of which the ST population is 3477 nos. Mainly the Pahadi Bhuyan Tribes are residing in this GP. Almost all the areas are hilly. The villagers are depending on one seasoned cultivation and labor. This GP has 02 SSD hostel, 06 no. UPS, 01 no High School, 01 no ANM centre. 07 nos. AWC, Asha Centre, and one no. of New PHC for Education and Health care respectively.

02. BAURIPADA GP. :- Bauripada GP hqr. is 14 Kms. away from Block hqr. The population of the GP is 8355 out of which the ST Population is 3620 nos. This GP consists of 11 nos. villages and 18 nos. of Wards. The GP has its own Office building. The GP has 34 nos. of GP Tanks. Mainly the villagers are cultivators and agricultural laborers. This GP has 02 no. of SSD hostel, 10 nos. of UPS one no. of High School for Education and 02 nos. of ANM Centre, Asha centre and 12 nos. of AWC for Health Facilities to villagers.

03. BODAPALASA GP :- The GP hqr., Bodapalasa is only 07 Kms. away from the Block hqr. This GP consists of 07 villages and 11 wards. The population of the GP is 7296 out of which 1521 nos. are belong to ST category. The GP has its own building, Cashew Orchards and 09 nos. of GP Tanks. Cultivation, Agricultural labor and to some extent small scale business are villagers main sources of income. This GP

has 01 SSD hostel. 06 nos. of UPS, 02 nos. of High Schools for providing Educational facilities and 07 nos. of AWC, Asha Centers and one ANM centre for Health Care.

04. DIMBO GP :- The distance of Dimbo is 05 kms. from Block hqr. Dimbo GP consists of 13 villages and 13 wards. The population of Dimbo GP is 7600 out of which ST population is 2960. The GP has own Building. Cultivation, Business and Agricultural labor are the villagers main livelihood. This GP has one Degree Engineering College, 02 nos. of High Schools, 12 nos. of UPS and one SSD hostel to provide education and 15 nos. of AWC, Asha Centre and one no. of ANM centre for Health care of villagers. The WSHG plays a vital rule to produce Badi in a large scale and to generate income of the women.

05. GOBARDHAN GP :- The GP is situated at a distance of 14 kms away from Block hqr. The GP consists of 06 no of revenue villages and 13 no of ward. The population of Gobardhan GP is 6011 out of which the ST categories are 2885. Business, vegetable business, agriculture and labor are the main activities of the villagers source of income. This GP has one SSD hostel, 05 nos. of UPS, 02 nos. of High Schools to provide education to villagers and 10 nos of AWC and one no. of ANM center for health care to villagers. The SHGs of this GP play a vital role for the income generation of women.

06. HANDIBHANGA GP :- The hqr of Handibhanga GP is 22 kms away from Block hqr. The population of the GP is 7840 out of which 4300 no are belong to ST category. The GP consists of 10 no revenue villages with 15 no of ward. Agriculture and Labor are the main livelihood factor of the villagers of this GP. This GP has 02 no. of SSD hostel, 10 no. of UPS one no. of High School to provide education and 13 no. of AWC, Asha centre and one ANM centre for health care to villagers.

07. JANARDANPUR GP :- GP hqr Janardanpur is located only 05 kms away from block hqr. The population of the GP is only 3067 no which one is the lowest populated GP of the Block. The GP consists of 04 revenue villages and 11 no of ward. The agricultural land of 02 villages of this GP are irrigated through Machakandana MIP. The ST population of the GP is 2291 no. Paddy cultivation and labor are the main income source factor of the villagers. The GP has one Degree Engineering College, one High Schools and 04 nos. of UPS to provide better education and 06 no. of AWC, Asha centre and one no. of ANM centre for health care to the villagers.

08. KANDRAPOSI GP :- GP hqr of Kandraposi GP is situated 25 kms away from Block hqr. This GP of Keonjhar Block is the boarder of Joda and Jhumpura Block of Keonjhar district. The population of this GP is 8622 out of which 6829 population belong to ST category. This GP consists 09 revenue villages and 16 no wards. Labor at Mines/factory and Agriculture field so also cultivation are the sources of income of villagers. This GP has 02 no. of SSD hostel, 13 no. of UPS and 02 no. of high schools for the educational facilities and 15 no. of AWC and one no. of ANM centre for provision of health care to the villagers.

09. KATHABARI GP :- Kathabari is the boarder GP of this Block to Ghatgaon and Patna Block. It is located 35 kms away from Block hqr. Population of this GP is 4918. This area is the coverage area under Kanjhari Irrigation Project. The villagers earned their livelihood mainly out of agriculture and labor. 2075 no population are belong to ST category. The GP consists of 08 revenue villages and 12 ward. This GP has one no. of SSD hostel, 10 no. of UPS, one no. of high school and 09 no. of AWC, Asha centre, and one no. of ANM centre to impart better education and health care of the villagers respectively.

10. KAUNRIKALA GP :- GP hqr of Kaunrikala GP is located 22 kms away from Block hqr. The population of the GP is 4197 out of which 1835 no belong to ST

category. The GP consists of 08 revenue villages and 11 no of ward. The villagers cultivated mainly vegetables and paddy. Some villagers depend on factories and other on labor. This GP has one SSD hostel, 06 no. of UPS, 02 no. of high schools to provide education and one no. of ANM centre, Asha centre, and 07 no. of AWC for health facilities for the villagers.

11. MAHADEIJODA :- Mahadeijoda is located 17 kms away from Block hqr. The total GP is covered by hilly areas. The population of Mahadeijoda GP is 6287 out of which ST category is 3281. This GP consists of 06 revenue villages and 12 no of ward. For livelihood point of view the villagers mainly depend on one seasoned crop, labor in agricultural field and factories. The name of the GP is legendary. Mahadeijoda was the summer residing palace of Maharani, Keonjhar. This GP has one Govt. Homeopathy Dispensary, one AWC centre, Asha centre and 11 no. of AWC centre to provide health care and one no. of SSD hostel, 12 no. of UPS and one high school to facilitate better education to the villagers.

12. MAIDANKEL :- Maidankel GP is 13 kms away from Block hqr and surrounded by forest. The population of this GP is 5764 no out of which the ST population is 2519. The GP consists of 10 no of revenue villages with 15 no of Wards. Most of the villagers depend on cash crop and labor. To impart proper health care the GP has one no. of New PHC, one ANM centre, Asha centre and 09 no. of AWC as well as to provide better education it has one SSD hostel, 10 no. of UPS and 02 no. of High Schools.

13. MANDUA :- Mandua GP is 02 kms away from Block Office. All the 08 no of villages are the periphery areas of Keonjhar Garh Municipality. The population of this GP is 7518 out of which SC categories are 3145 and ST categories are 2811 no. The GP is organized by 11 wards. As because the villages are very adjacent to town most of the villagers depend on Keonjhar Garh municipality. One seasoned paddy crop, different type of business and laboring are the main activities of the villagers livelihood. This GP has one SSD hostel, 05 no. of UPS, one high school to provide education and one ANM centre, Asha centre and 10. No. of AWC to facilitate health care to the villagers.

14. NARANPUR :- Naranpur GP hqr is located only 05 kms away from Block hqr. The population of this GP is 9744 out of which the ST population is 4528 no. Naranpur GP has 14 revenue villages and 14 wards. Most of the Keonjhar railway passengers depend on Naranpur Railway Station. The villagers of Naranpur GP depend on Agriculture, Business and laboring. To facilitate better education and health care to the villagers the GP has 02 no. of SSD hostel, 11 no. of UPS, 02 no. of high school and 02 no. of ANM centre, Asha centre and 13 no. of AWC centre respectively.

15. NELUNG GP :- Nelung GP hqr is located only 05 kms away from Block hqr. The population of Nelung GP is 5256 no out of which the ST population is 2643. The GP consists of 07 no of revenue villages with 11 no of ward. The villagers of Nelung GP depend on one seasoned crop, Laboring and Business to maintain their livelihood. This GP has one Degree College, 02 no. of SSD hostel, 08 no. of UPS, one no. of high school to impart education and one no. of ANM centre, Asha centre and 09 no. of AWC centre to provide health care to the villagers respectively.

16. NUAGAON GP :- The GP hqr of Nuagaon GP is 20 kms away from Block hqr. This GP consists of 13 no of revenue villages with 19 ward. The population of Nuagaon GP is 8985 out of which 5597 are belong to ST category. Most of the villagers depend on crop, business and laboring to maintain their livelihood. This GP has 15 no. of UPS, 02 no. of high school, 02 no. of SSD hostel to impart education and 15 no. of AWC centre, Asha centre and two no. of ANM centre to deliver health care to the villagers. The Hat of this GP is the biggest hat of Block.

17. PADAMPUR GP :- GP hqr of Padampur is located 12 kms away from Block hqr. The population of the GP is 7067 no. out of which ST categories are 4213. The GP consists of 08 revenue villages with 11 no. of ward. Business, Cropping and laboring are the main essential factor of sources of income of the GP villagers. This GP has a Degree College, 09 no. of UPS, 02 no. of high school and one no. of SSD hostel to impart education and one CHC, one ANM centre, Asha centre and 09 no. of AWW centre to provide health care of the villagers.

18. PALASPONGA GP :- Palasponga GP hqr is situated 18 kms away from Block hqr. This GP consists of 13 revenue villages and 14 no. of ward. The population of this GP is 7616 out of which 3151 no. belong to ST category. Most of the villagers of this GP are engaged in factory and mines area, agricultural field and laboring. SPONGE IRON ORE LIMITED and MSP steel Plant are situated in this GP. The GP has one SSD hostel, 08 no. of UPS and one high school to impart education and one no. of ANM centre, Asha centre and 12 no. of AWW centre to care the health of the villagers.

19. PARJANPUR GP :- Parjanpur GP hqr. is 24 Kms away from Block hqr. The population of Parjanpur GP is 6865 out of which 2962 no. of population belong to ST category. The GP consists 13 no. of revenue villages with 14 ward. The main livelihood activities of the villagers of Parjanpur are Agriculture, Laboring. For health care point of view the GP has one new PHC, 02 no. of ANM centre, Asha centre and 11 no. of AWW centre. To provide education to the villagers the GP has one SSD hostel, one high school and 12 no. of UPS.

20. RAGHUNATHPUR GP :- The hqr of Raghunathpur GP is located 27 kms away from Block hqr. and is covered under Kanjhari Irrigation Project. The Population of this GP is 7504 and out of this 3367 no. of people are belong to ST category. The GP consists of 16 no. of revenue villages with 15 ward. The main livelihood activities of the villagers are Paddy cultivation, vegetable cropping and laboring. For better health care to villagers the GP has one Govt. Homeopathy Dispensary, 02 no. of ANM centre, Asha centre and 16 no. of AWW centre. To impart education the GP has one no. of SSD hostel, 13 no. of UPS and 02 no. of High Schools.

21. RAIKALA GP :- The hqr of Raikala GP is 28 Kms away from Block hqr. The population of this GP 6701, out of this 3237 no are belong to ST category. The GP consists of 11 no of revenue villages with 14 no of ward. The basic livelihood of the villagers are cropping and laboring both in factory/mines and agricultural field. This GP is the boarder area of Keonjhargarh block and adjacent to Jhumpura Block. To deliver health care to the villagers the GP has one no. of ANM centre, Asha centers, and 12 no. of AWW centre likewise to provide education it has 11 nos. of UPS/MES and 02 no. of High Schools.

22. RAISUAN GP :- Raisuan GP is located 07 kms away from Block hqr. It is the thickly populated GP of Keonjhargarh Block with a population of 10533 and ST population of 5407 no. This GP consists of 12 revenue villages organized with 18 ward. Basically the villagers main livelihood activities are Agriculture, Business and labor in both agriculture and non-agriculture field. For health care point of view the GP has one New PHC, 01 no. of ANM centre, Asha centers, and 15 no. of AWW centers. To deliver better education the GP has one +2 College, 10 no. of UPS, one high school and one SSD hostel.

23. SANKIRI GP :- Sankiri GP hqr is 24 kms away from Block hqr. The population of this GP is 4792, out of which the ST categories are 2522. This GP consists of 06 revenue villages with 11 no. of wards. Basically the villagers are depending on agriculture and laboring in both the fields. The GP has one New PHC, 02 no. of ANM centre, Asha centre, 09 no. of AWW centre to facilitate the health care of the villagers. To impart better education to the children it has 07 no. of UPS/MES and 02 no. of high schools.

24. SIRISPAL GP :- Sirispal GP hqr is only 12 kms away from Block hqr. It consists 08 no. of revenue villages with 12 no. of Ward. The population of this GP is 8412, out of which 3539 are tribals. The livelihood activities of the villagers are agriculture and laboring. For education point of view this GP carries one Sevashram, 02 no. of SSD hostel, 10 no. of UPS /MES and one no. of high school and to deliver health care to the villagers the GP has 09 no. of AWW, 01 no. of ANM and Asha centers.

Mo-Dakhyata, Mo-Sahara & Scholarships to poor talented students are the own schemes of the GP that speak volumes of its overall excellence. This G.P is famous for Maa Tarini Temple & the scenic beauty of Gundichaghagi water fall. Chaiti Parba,Ghatgaon Mahotshab &Ravanpodi are the impotent festive occasions that lure a number of tourists to the G.P. The G.P has a good source of own income from its market complexes & Hat .

02. Khantaghar G.P

Khantaghar GP under Ghatgaon Block is 15 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 3223.(ST 2285 SC 209 & others 393 households 706). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 4 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 4 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health.The G.P has 5 no of primary / Upper primary schools . There is one mobile tower for better communication purposes.

03. Pipilia GP

Pipilia GP under Ghatgaon Block is 22 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 4847.(ST 3265 SC 175 & others 568 households 1101). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 5 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 5 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 7 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 03 high schools. L.N Mahavidyalaya ,Pipilia is an important centre of higher education for the tribal dominated people of this G.P. There are 07 mobile towers for better communication purposes.

04. Dhenkikote GP

Dhenkikote GP under Ghatgaon Block is 13 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 5181.(ST 2596 SC 259 & others 619 households 1217). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 4 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 5 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 7 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 02 high schools. S.N Mahavidyalaya ,Dhenkikote is an

important centre of higher education for the tribal dominated people of this G.P. There is 02 mobile towers for better communication purposes.

05. Manoharpur GP

Manoharpur GP under Ghatgaon Block is 20 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 4895.(ST 3735 SC 157 & others 656 households 1022). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 8 no of revenue villages with 12 no of wards & 08 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 09 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 02 high schools. There is 01 mobile tower for better communication purposes. Sitabinj, an ancient center of historical importance is one of the significant tourist attractions of Keonjhar district. Visitors from all around Odisha come here to witness the natural stone carvings , stone paintings of Ramayan Era & other scenic wonders of this hilly region.

06. Bholabeda GP

Bholabeda GP under Ghatgaon Block is 23 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 3706.(ST 2819 SC 195 & others 493 households 874). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 03 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 03 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 05 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school.

07. Basantapur GP

Basantapur GP under Ghatgaon Block is 40 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 4313.(ST 2777 SC 401 & others 583 households 1010). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 4 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 5 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 05 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school. There are 03 mobile towers for better communication purposes.

08. Patilo GP

Patilo GP under Ghatgaon Block is 28 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 3860.(ST 2352 SC 291 & others 488 households 968). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 9 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 5 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 7 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school. There is 01 mobile tower for better communication purposes. There is 01 Jagannath temple & 01 Shiv temple in this G.P for religious purposes.

09. Binida GP

Binida GP under Ghatgaon Block is 30 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 3627.(ST 2410 SC 223 & others 569 households 812). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 04 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 5 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 05 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school. There is 01 mobile tower for better communication purposes.

10.Paidapatna GP

Paidapatna GP under Ghatgaon Block is 12 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 4006.(ST 2677 SC 169 & others 495 households 962). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 04 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 04 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 05 no of primary / Upper primary schools .

11. Santarapur GP

Santarapur GP under Ghatgaon Block is 16 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 4759.(ST 2901 SC 440 & others 659 households 1075). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 03 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 04 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 06 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school. The GP is home to Juangas, one of the oldest tribes of India like Jayantia, Garo,Khasi,Jarwas & Dangariyas. The Kuladera village, a hilly terrain of Santarapur GP is the home of Juangas.

12. Toranipokhari GP

Toranipokhari GP under Ghatgaon Block is 28 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 6496.(ST 3564 SC 373 & others 888 households 1483). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 10 no of revenue villages with 14 no of wards & 09 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 10 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 02 high schools. There are 02 mobile towers for better communication purposes.

13. Badajamupasi GP

Badajamupasi GP under Ghatgaon Block is 07 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 7826.(ST 5164 SC 182 & others 1111 households 1622). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 07 no of revenue villages with 15 no of wards & 05 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 10 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 03 high schools. There is 01 mobile tower for better communication purposes.

14. Pandapada GP

Pandapada GP under Ghatgaon Block is 30 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 3521.(ST 2421 SC 92 & others 505 households 851). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 04 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 04 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 06 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school. There are 02 mobile towers for better communication purposes.

15. Sunatangiri GP

Sunatangiri GP under Ghatgaon Block is 32 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 3327.(ST 2705 SC 05 & others 437 households 824). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 03 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 03 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 04 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school. The GP headquarter in Sunatangiri is yet to be constructed as the proposed location has been a bone of contention among the 03 villages.

16. PurumundaGP

Purumunda GP under Ghatgaon Block is 34 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 4937.(ST 3515 SC 427 & others 615 households 1119). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 07 no of revenue villages with 11 no of wards & 05 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 07 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 01 high school. The GP is home to Juangas, one of the

oldest tribes of India like Jayantia, Garo, Khasi, Jarwas & Dangariyas. The Gayalmunda village, a hilly terrain of Purumunda GP is the home of Juangas.

17. Upperdiha GP

Upperdiha GP under Ghatgaon Block is 1 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 8513.(ST 5168 SC 520 & others 1442 households 1850). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 05 no of revenue villages with 12 no of wards & 07 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 12 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 03 high schools. There are 08 mobile towers for better communication purposes.

18. Gadadharpur GP

Gadadharpur GP under Ghatgaon Block is 7 K.m from Block headquarter. The total no of population is 4017.(ST 1934 SC 154 & others 518 households 938). The main source of livelihoods is agriculture. There are 06 no of revenue villages with 12 no of wards & 05 no of polling stations. The people have easy access to education and health. The G.P has 06 no of primary / Upper primary schools & 02 high schools. There are 03 mobile towers for better communication purposes. Apart from agriculture Terracotta is booming into an important source of small cottage industry especially in the village of Bataharichandanpur , Gadadharpur. Sanischar temple amidst the scenic beauty of jungle is the main centre of religious activities for the G.P.

19. Tara GP
