As such a total stock of 312,000 ltrs of S.K.Oil is hereby re-allotted against the Blocks / ULBs/Wholesalers @ 0.738 ltr. per card per tri- month of April, May & June, 2025 as per ratio on the basis of FPSs wise allotment downloaded online for the month of April, May & June, 2025, for distribution among the ration card under 417002 NFSA and 5614 SFSS families (Total=422616) holders identified under NFSA and SFSS, observing all formalities and strictly following the guidelines stipulated by the Govt.

1. The following instruction should be followed strictly for ensuring meticulously distribution among the ration card (both PHH & AAY ration card) holders identified under NFSA, 2013 and SFSS (as per FPS-wise Sales Registers generated and available in the RCMS login) on per card basis @ 0.738 ltr per card for the tri-month i.e. for the month of **April, May & June, 2025**.

2. Distribution of SK Oil at FPS point should be made only through E-PoS Device. Sales through manual mode should be discouraged as far as practicable. In exigency or in worst circumstances, manual mode of distribution should be restored to only after due approval of concerned BDO/EO with proper justification thereon. The FPS wise sale register should be downloaded in PoS device after 1st date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device. The dateline for activities is as follows:-

1.	Delivery of S.K. Oil quota to Wholesalers by OMC from its Depots	Immediate
2.	Lifting and Delivery of S.K. Oil quota to all Fair Price Shops by Wholesalers	30 th April, 2025 to 28 th June, 2025
3.	Distribution to beneficiaries by Fair Price Shops through e-PoS	30 th April, 2025 to 30 th June, 2025

3. Due care should be taken so that PDS K.Oil is not being diverted otherwise, miss-used for adulteration in MS/HSD retail out-lets or commercial vehicles. Stringent action shall be taken against dealer found indulged in such unfair trade practices. Wide publicity to be made on distribution, scale & quantum of supply. The utilisation of SK Oil is meant for cooking and lighting purpose only.

4. The Tally Register of the FPS retailers will be authenticated by the concerned M.I. / I.S./ ACSOs for issue of K.Oil to them by the K.Oil Wholesalers.


5. The date of distribution shall be widely published for benefit of retailers and other stakeholders.

6. The retailers should be instructed to make advance deposit of cost of K.Oil with the in shape of Bank Draft/Cheque or through RTGS / NEFT / ECS as per their allotment.

7. The FPS retailer shall sell kerosene to the consumers, as far as possible in presence of some members of GPLAC / WLAC. The Advisory Committees shall certify proper distribution of S.K.Oil by the retailers.

8. The wholesaler shall intimate the arrival of stock to BDO / Sub-Collector / CSO of the concerned Block through SMS on the same day. Arrival report in writing is to be submitted by the wholesaler on the same day or next day to the BDO or Sub-Collector of the Block/ULB.

9. The concerned M.I./I.S will verify the stock after its arrival for effecting delivery on fixed distribution dates. ACSOs/I.S.s will ensure that per head entitlement of SK Oil shall not be reduced below the prescribed allotment and conduct verification of minimum 25% of sale every month.


