This includes three (03) years of comprehensive hardware warranty and software support.</p> | <p>It is requested that the following provision be incorporated under Clause 3.6(iv):</p> <p>3.6(iv): c. The rates finalized through this RFP shall remain valid for the entire contract period of three (03) years. During this period, the Purchaser may place repeat orders for additional devices, accessories, consumables and related services at the approved rates and terms.</p> <p>Remarks: Since the actual number of tests conducted may exceed the estimated quantities, additional consumables may be required during the 3-year contract period. Retaining approved rates for future procurement will ensure continuity of services and timely availability of consumables.</p> | <p>The rates finalized under this RFP shall be applicable only to the quantities and scope specified in the contract.</p> <p>In case of operational requirements during the contract period, the quantity of recurring items, consumables and other non-capital items may be increased, subject to actual requirement, availability of funds, and approval of the Competent Authority at the rates finalized under the contract.</p> <p>However, no additional procurement of instruments, equipment, or other capital assets beyond the quantities originally awarded under the contract shall be permitted at the approved rates.</p> <p>Accordingly, no provision for placement of repeat orders for instruments or capital equipment beyond the scope of the awarded contract shall be incorporated in the RFP.</p> |
