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Section - I

TERMS & CONDITION FOR TROPONIN – T DEVICE & SNAKE VENOM RAPID DETECTION KIT" FOR DIFFERENT HEALTH FACILITY OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT

1. Sealed bids will be received by **Dt 30-07-2026** up to **05.00 PM.** by the Chief District Medical & Public Health Officer, Keonjhar through Speed Post / Regd. Post / courier only. Any tender received after the due date & time will be rejected / returned to the sender unopened.
2. A pre-bid meeting shall be held on **Dt 14-07-2026** for any clarification of the bidder.
3. Bid will be submitted in One parts i.e. Technical Bid (Cover – A) and Financial Bid (Cover – B). The bidders should give their technical and financial proposal separately in One envelope and both should be put into third cover which should be super scribed as **"Supply of Troponin - T quantitative device & Snake Venom Rapid Detection Kit for different Health Facility of Keonjhar District"**. The bidders qualified in the technical bid will be eligible to participate in financial bid. Tender documents should reach to the office of the undersigned either through Speed Post / Regd. Post & Courier only. The bid inviting authority is not responsible for any postal delay.
4. The Sealed bids "Cover A" (Technical Bid) submitted by the bidders will be opened in the mini conference hall, NHM, on **Dt 31-07-2026**. The bidder or their duly authorized representatives are allowed to be present during the opening of the tender. No bid documents shall be accepted after the expiry of scheduled date and time for receipt of bids. The details of items and specifications are mentioned at **Annexure-IV.**
5. The GST shall be charged as applicable. All the payments are to be made through Treasury/PFMS mode to the concerned party.
6. The decision of the Purchase committee is final and reserves all rights to go for quality testing of the goods prior to release of payments.
7. The door step delivery/installation (SDH/CHC/PHC) of the goods/materials has to be taken care of by the bidders without any extra payments for the same.
8. The door step delivery/installation of the goods/materials has to be taken care of by the bidders without any extra payments for the same.
9. The prices quoted must be inclusive of all charges & freight if any but exclusive of GST.
10. The L1 price finalised will be valid for One years from the date of finalisation of tender and may be extended for a further period after due approval from the Authority.
11. The time line of finalization of tender may vary or extend depending upon the emergency/exigency of demand of the situation if any.
12. Incomplete tender shall be rejected and the undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
13. The bill shall be processed only against a valid supply order. The L1(lowest) bidder shall not impose any preconditions regarding the fixation of specific quantities or supply commitments outside the scope of the tender. The quantity to be order shall be as per the actual requirement and the successful bidder is bound to supply the ordered quantity accordingly. Failure by L1 bidder to comply with the supplies order or refusal to delivery as per the specified requirement shall result in termination of their contract.


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In such a case, all the order may be placed to the L2(Second lowest) bidder at L1 rate and L1 bidder will be based from receiving any further order under this contract or future tender also.

14. Sample should be submitted before bulk supply order.

15. All legal disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of Keonjhar Court only.

A- Tender Processing Fee and EMD:

1. The Tender processing fee of **Rs.5,000/- (non-refundable)** should be submitted by the bidder in shape of Bank Draft in favour of "**ZSS XV FC KEONJHAR**" and payable at **Keonjhar** from any nationalised bank long with bid for verification.

2. The bidder shall submit EMD of **Rs. 1,50,000 (One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only)** in shape of Bank Draft in favour of "**ZSS XV FC KEONJHAR**" and payable at **Keonjhar** from any nationalized bank as per the details mentioned below

EMD of successful bidders will be kept as Performance Security which will be returned after expiry of rate contracts or till publication of next rate contracts. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after publication of rate contract.

B. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA.

Manufacturer/Distributors / Wholesalers / C&F Agents/local suppliers are eligible to participate in the tender provided; they have:

(i) Bidders should have a valid drug license.

(ii) Bidder should have valid ISO/CE/USFDA/WHO GMP/GMP Certificate of the products.

(iii) Bidder should have average annual turnover of Rs. 1 crore in the last three years (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25).

(iv) Bidder / OEM should submit Proof of supply of same/ Similar items to Govt. hospitals (at least 01 number of latest order copies.

(v) Bidder should have valid PAN Card, GST registration certificate.

(vi) Bidder should have bid specific OEM authorization for the items applied.

(vii) Proof of supply of the same or similar items to any Govt. Hospital/PSU Hospital/Corporate Hospitals in the last 1 year.

(viii) Copy of valid Wholesale / Distributor / Manufacturer license /Drug Licence from the Drug Controller.

(ix) Self-attested copies of valid CDSCO licenses, as required under the attached specifications, shall be submitted.

C. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONGWITH TECHNICAL BID (COVER – A).

1. Bidders should submit photo copy of valid drug license.

2. Bidder should submit Valid ISO/CE/USFDA/WHO GMP/GMP Certificate of the products in technical bid document.

3. The bidder must submit detail catalogue and other supporting documents of products indicating detail specification and features of the product in the format provided in **Annexure-I**.

4. Documentary evidence in support of Average Annual turnover of **Rs. 1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One**


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Crore only) for last three years (i.e. for the financial years 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25) in the format provided in **Annexure - II**. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited balance sheet of relevant periods and turnover certificate from the Chartered Accountants indicating the turnover details for the relevant periods shall be submitted with the documents.

5. Bidder / OEM should submit Proof of supply of same/ similar items to any Govt. Hospitals. At least 01 (One number) of latest order copies for each item must be submitted.
6. Bidder should submit PAN Card, GST registration certificate along with the Technical Bid.
7. Bidder should submit income tax return copy for last three F.Y years (i.e.2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25).
8. Bidder should submit GST return for last three months (March-26, April-26 & May-26).
9. Bidder must submit Tender specific OEM authorization of the articles applied in the format provided in **Annexure - III**.
10. **The Firm/Agency will have to submit the Affidavit on non-judiciary stamp paper worth Rs. 20/- with the following clauses: -**
 - i. That, the firm /agency have not been blacklisted / debarred by any Central / Sate Government organization / Bodies for the last 3 years.
 - ii. That, the firm / agency have not committed any offence under the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988.
 - iii. That, the authority will have no liability regarding transportation, loading and unloading of material and all the material ordered shall be delivered at the designated place in good condition. The defective or damaged material if any will be replaced.
 - iv. That, the firm / agency agrees has to abide by all the terms & conditions of the tender.
 - v. That, the firm / agency will quote the price excluding GST.
 - vi. That, the firm / agency is abide by the Indian Penal code or any other law for the time being in force, for causing any loss of life or property or causing a threat to public health as part of execution of a public procurement contract.
 - vii. That, the firm / agency agrees to abide by all terms & conditions of the Tender.

D. Evaluation:

1. Tenders will be evaluated as per the requirement of the bid and the price bid (Cover-B) shall be opened only for the bidders, who will qualify in the technical evaluation.
2. Item wise evaluation will be done.
3. The cost of the unit item excluding Taxes / GST will be evaluated but including all type of charges.
4. If the approved lowest eligible supplier fails to supply ordered items within the stipulated period, to meet the need, the tender inviting authority reserves right to procure the same from the participated bidders at L1 rate, if they agree to supply at L1 approved rate.

D. Performance Security:

1. The EMD shall have to keep as performance security.

E. Delivery


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1. Supply shall be completed within 45 days (maximum) from the date of issue of purchase order or as mentioned in this purchase order along with test report.
2. Delivery shall be made at any health facilities (DHH/SDH/CHC/PHC) of Keonjhar District. List of the Health facility/quantity should be provided at the time of Order.
